The CSI Calgary High Performance Sport Award is awarded to students pursuing a Masters or PhD in the area of Sport Science. The award supports students with a passion for high performance sport research and or applied sport science field work.

Application Deadline: July 15th, 2020

Interview Dates: July 16th - July 31st 2020

Award notification: by Aug 15th, 2020

Eligibility Criteria:

- Be a Canadian Citizen or Permanent Resident
- Accepted at University of Calgary Faculty of Graduate Studies to study in the area of sport science
- Completion of application process
 - Application form
 - Two Reference letters
 - Transcripts
 - Current Curriculum Vitae or Resume
- Nomination from CSI staff member
- Affiliation with CSI Calgary or another CSI institute
- Proven track record in high performance sport
- Must be registered as a full-time student status

Level of Study

- Masters or PhD

Selection Process:

A committee comprised of CSI staff members will review and rank each candidates' application and interview. Selection is based on the needs and goals of the CSI Calgary and candidate ranking.

Value:

- \$22,000 per year (Sept 1st, 2020 to Aug 31st, 2021; Sept 1st, 2021 to Aug 31st, 2022) to a maximum of 2 years.
- \$2000 conference travel allowance to present thesis work
