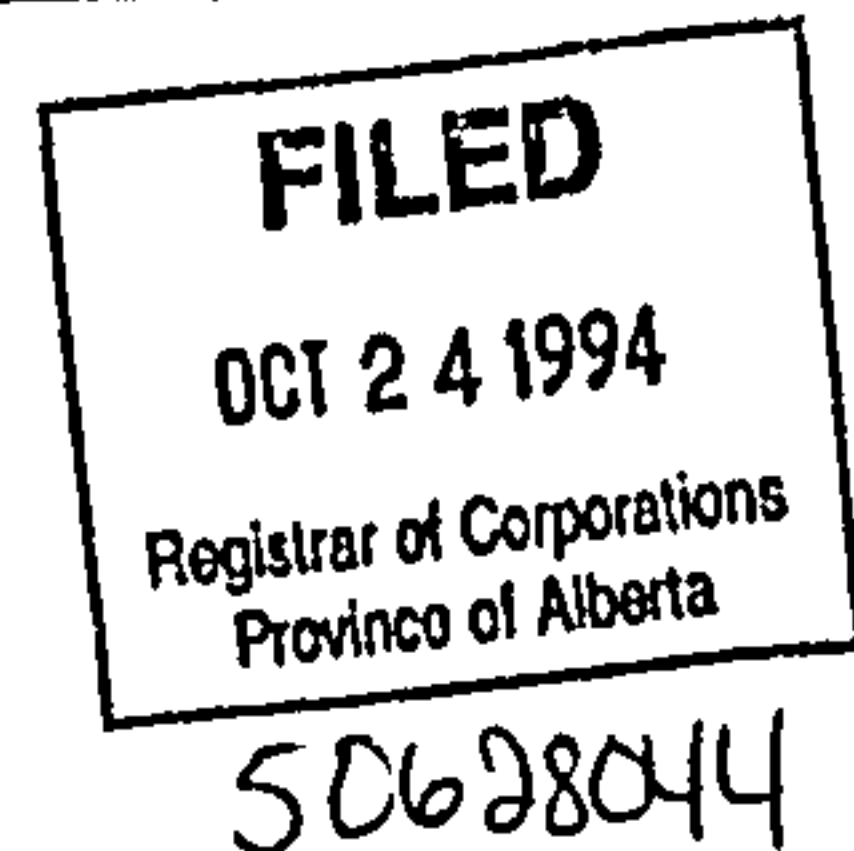

WE, the undersigned, hereby declare that we desire to form a Society (the "Society") under the Societies Act, R.S.A. 1980, and that:

1. The name of the Society is **NATIONAL MULTI-SPORT DEVELOPMENT CENTRE - CALGARY.**
2. The objects of the Society are:
 - a) to enhance the training environment for Calgary-based high performance athletes through the provision of appropriate support services and programs to athletes and coaches;
 - b) to strengthen the high performance athlete development system in Calgary through coordinated delivery of essential program components;
 - c) to provide a focal point for coordinated high performance sport programming on a sport-specific basis by sport organizations at the club, provincial, and national levels;
 - d) to promote collaboration and information sharing among high performance coaches and athletes and others from various sport disciplines;
 - e) to develop ongoing mechanisms, involving the participation of athletes and coaches, by which to monitor and evaluate the success of the pilot project;
 - f) to develop economic and cost sensitive methods to carry out the business of the National Multi-Sport Development Centre - Calgary;
 - g) to solicit and receive by gift, bequest, devise, transfer or otherwise, property of every nature and description;

- h) subject to any prior trust conditions imposed on the use of the property referred to in clause g), to hold, use and administer the property generally for the support of the promotion of sports and in particular to finance or assist in the financing of the development of sports; and
- i) to sell, manage, lease, mortgage, dispose of or otherwise deal with the property of the Society.
3. The Society is to be operated without benefit to its members and all profits and undertakings of the Society shall be used in pursuing the stated objects of the Society.

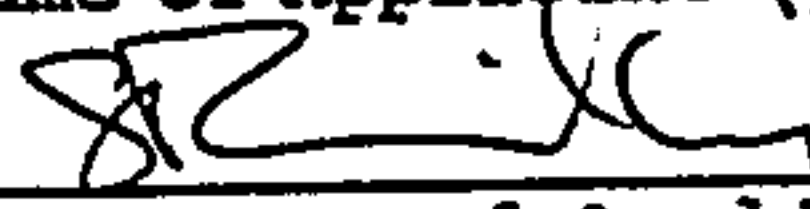

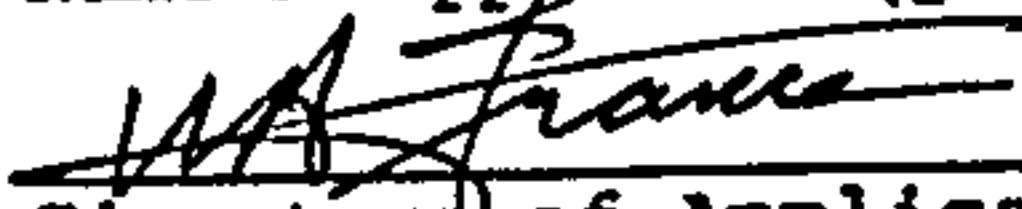

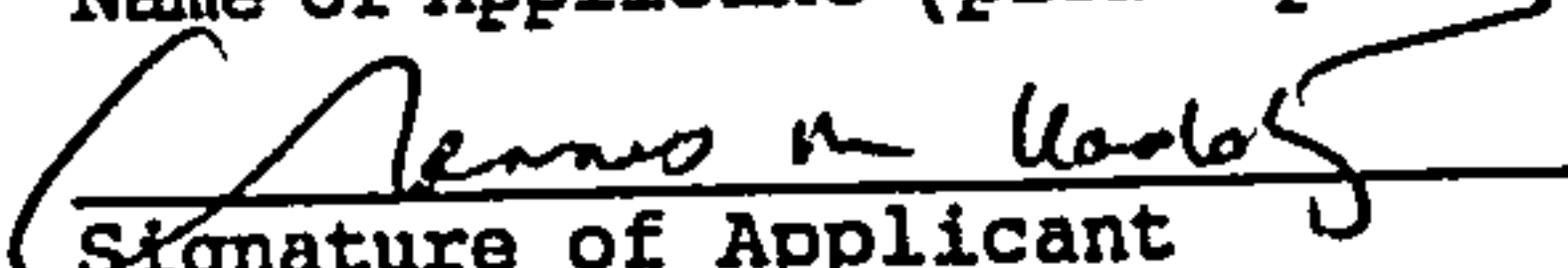

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**A BY-LAW GOVERNING THE PROCEDURE AND
BUSINESS OF NATIONAL MULTI-SPORT
DEVELOPMENT CENTRE - CALGARY
("THE SOCIETY")**

BE IT HEREBY ENACTED as a By-Law of the Society as follows:

Section 1 - Interpretation

1.01 Definitions

In all By-Laws of the Society, unless the context otherwise specifies or requires:

- a) "Active Member" or "Membership" means an Active Member in good standing appointed pursuant to Section 2.
- b) "Associate Member" means a member who has paid the dues prescribed in Section 2.
- c) "Act" means the Societies Act, R.S.A. 1980 Ch. S-18 as from time to time amended and every statute that may be substituted therefore and, in the case of such substitution, any references in the By-Laws of the Society to the provisions of the Act shall be read as references to the substituted provisions in the new statute or statutes.
- d) "Annual Meeting" means the Annual Meeting called pursuant to Section 12.01.
- e) "Appoint" includes "elect" and vice versa.
- f) "Board" means the Board of Directors of the Society.
- g) "By-Laws" means this By-Law and all other By-Laws of the Society from time to time in force and effect.
- h) "Steering Committee" shall mean those persons initially appointed by the funding partners for the purposes of creating the National Multi-Sport Development Centre - Calgary.

i) "Funding Partner" shall mean the following:

1. Calgary Olympic Development Association,
2. Canadian Olympic Association,
3. Coaching Association of Canada,
4. Sport Canada,
5. Alberta Sport, Recreation, Parks and Wildlife Foundation, and
6. Faculty of Physical Education, University of Calgary.

1.02 Interpretation

Save as aforesaid, all terms contained in the By-Laws of the Society which are defined in the Act or regulations shall have the meaning given to such terms in the Act or regulations. Words importing the singular number include the plural and the converse shall also apply. Words importing gender include the masculine, feminine and neutral genders.

1.03 Headings

The headings preceding the clauses of the By-Laws have been inserted for convenience of reference only and shall not be considered or taken into account to constrain the terms or provisions of the By-Laws, nor deemed in any way to qualify, modify or explain the effect of any such terms or provisions.

Section 2 - Membership

2.01 Membership Fees

Membership fees, if any, in the Society shall be determined from time to time by the Board.

2.02 Membership

Membership in the Society shall be divided into such number of classes as may be decided from time to time by the Board of Directors, but initially there shall be two (2) classes of membership; namely, "active membership" and "associate membership".

Any person may become an Active Member by a favourable vote passed by the Board. Each person who is a Director shall be automatically an Active Member. Each Active Member shall be entitled to one (1) vote.

Any person may become an Associate Member upon payment of the membership fee prescribed by the Board. Associate Members, as such, shall not be entitled to vote at any meetings of the Society.

The Board may effect such right to any other classes of membership which it may create and shall be entitled to set dues or membership fees for any of such classes of membership created.

2.03 Withdrawal from Membership

Any Member wishing to withdraw from membership may do so upon giving a notice in writing to the Board through its Secretary.

2.04 Expulsion

Any Active Member may be expelled from membership in the Society for any cause which the Society deems reasonable upon a resolution to that effect being passed by at least sixty-six (66%) Percent of the votes cast at a meeting of the Board.

Section 3 - Board of Directors

3.01 Board of Directors

The affairs of the Board of Directors of the Society shall be managed by a Board of not more than twelve (12) Directors. The Directors shall be drawn from the following groups, which groups are considered to be the constituent group of the Society as follows:

- a) The funding partners.
- b) Athletes and Coaches.
- c) The community.

The Board may exercise all such powers and do all such acts and things as may be exercised or done by the Society and are not by the By-Laws of the Society or by this By-Law expressly directed or required to be done by the Society. The Board of Directors shall be constituted as follows:

- a) One (1) Director nominated by the Calgary Olympic Development Association.

- b) One (1) Director nominated by the Canadian Olympic Association.
- c) One (1) Director nominated by the Coaching Association of Canada.
- d) One (1) Director nominated by Sport Canada.
- e) One (1) Director nominated by the Alberta Sport Recreation, Parks and Wildlife Foundation.
- f) One (1) Director nominated by the Faculty of Physical Education, University of Calgary.
- g) Two (2) Directors nominated by The National Multi-Sport Development Centre - Athletes Advisory Council (NMSDC-AAC).
- h) Two (2) Directors nominated by Coaches coaching high performance athletes training in the Calgary area and actively involved in coaching in the Calgary area.
- i) Two (2) Directors nominated by the nominating committee constituted in Section 7 of these By-Laws which Directors shall be from the community at large and be persons whose contribution to the affairs of the Society is of paramount importance.

It is recognized that where vacancies are created by the aforementioned nominators not nominating or filling their appointed directorship that the Board may fill such vacancy with a Director approved by a majority vote of the remaining Directors.

3.02

Appointment of Directors

The initial Directors shall be appointed by the Steering Committee appointed for the purposes of establishing the Society. Thereafter the Directors shall be appointed from time to time as required, by the Chairperson of the Society upon the recommendation and nominations set forth in Paragraph 3.01.

3.03

Term

The Directors shall be appointed for a term not to exceed two (2) years and may have their term renewed if renominated by their constituent group.

3.04 Removal of Directors

Subject to the Act, the Society may, by Special Resolution passed at a Special Meeting specifically called for such purpose, remove any Director.

3.05 Vacancies

Subject to the Act, the Directors may, from time to time, appoint a person as a Director for the purpose of filling a vacancy on the Board created by the resignation or removal of a Director, but in so doing must appoint such replacement directly from the membership of the appropriate constituent set out in paragraph 3.01.

3.06 Remuneration and Expenses

The payment of any dividend or remuneration out of the funds of the Society to any of the Directors is prohibited. Any reimbursement for expenses is the responsibility of the constituent group appointing any such Director.

3.07 Meetings

Meetings of the Board shall be held at such time and on such days as the Chairperson of the Society may, from time to time, determine. The holding of any meeting in the form of a telephone conference call is permitted.

3.08 Special Meetings

Meetings of the Board may be called on the requisitions of any two (2) Directors provided that such request shall be made to the Chairperson, in writing, to call such meeting and such request shall state the business to be brought before the meeting.

3.09 Notice of Meeting

Meetings of the Board shall be called by ten (10) days notice, in writing, mailed to each Director or by three (3) days notice given by telecopy, telefax, telegram or telephone.

3.10 Quorum

A quorum for the transaction of business at any meeting of the Board shall be a majority of the Directors.

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3.11 Voting

Questions arising at any meeting of the Board shall be decided by a majority of votes cast at that meeting. In the case of an equality of votes, the Chairperson of the meeting shall not have a second or casting vote and the question in such case shall be considered lost.

3.12 Resolution in Writing

A resolution in writing signed by all the Directors personally shall be valid and effectual as if it had been passed at a meeting of the Board duly called and constituted.

Section 4 - Appointment and Duties of Officers4.01 Appointment

The Directors shall elect as Officers, a Chairperson, a Vice-Chairperson, a Secretary and a Treasurer who shall hold office for a term of one (1) year or until that person resigns or is discharged by the Board. The Board may appoint such other officers as they determine necessary who shall have such authority and shall perform such duties as may from time to time be prescribed by the Directors. One (1) Director may hold at any time two (2) offices.

4.02 Chairperson

The Chairperson presides at all meetings of the Society and of the Directors and should be entrusted to carry out all orders and resolutions of The Board of Directors.

4.03 Vice-Chairperson

The Vice-Chairperson shall, in the absence of the Chairperson, exercise the duties of the Chairperson and shall preside at all meetings of the Society and of the Board of Directors in the absence of the Chairperson. The Vice-Chairperson shall be entitled to a vote at all proceedings of the Society.

4.04

Secretary

It shall be the duty of the Secretary to attend all meetings of the Society and of the Board, and to keep accurate Minutes of those meetings. The Secretary shall have charge of the seal of the Society. In the absence of the Secretary, those duties shall be discharged by any Officer appointed by the Board. The Secretary shall be entitled to a vote at all proceedings of the Society.

4.05

Treasurer

The Treasurer shall receive all monies paid to the Society and shall be responsible for the deposit of same in whatever bank, trust company, credit union or Treasury Branch that the Board may order. The Treasurer shall properly account for the funds of the Society and keep such books as may be directed. The Treasurer shall present a full detailed account of receipts and disbursements to the Board whenever requested and shall ensure that there is prepared, for submission to the Annual Meeting, an audited statement of the financial position of the Society. The Treasurer shall be entitled to a vote at all proceedings of the Society.

4.06

President

The President within the policy guidelines determined by the Board of Directors, shall assume primary responsibility for the policies, programs and activities of the Society. He shall represent the Society as its Senior Officer in major negotiations with other bodies on behalf of the Society's interest and shall maintain community and liaison with all other key groups and agencies. He shall have the key responsibility in respect of primary planning, strategic advocacy and management of the Society and shall be responsible for promotions and public relations as may be required. He shall be assigned such specific tasks and additional responsibilities as may be determined by the Board from time to time. The President shall sit as an ex-officio and non-voting member of the Board of Directors and shall be directly responsible to the Board of Directors through the office of the Chairperson.

Section 5 - Executive Committee

- 5.01 An Executive Committee made up of the President of the Society, the Chairperson of the Society or his/her designate, and one other Director appointed by the Board of Directors shall be responsible for the carrying on of the day to day operations of the Society.

Section 6 - Committee or Subcommittees

- 6.01 The Board of Directors may appoint and establish such committees or subcommittees as may be required from time to time to ensure that the objectives of the Society are met. Such Committees or Subcommittees shall remain constituted at the pleasure of the Board of Directors.

Section 7 - Nominating Committee

7.01 Nominating Committee

The Board shall constitute a Nominating Committee composed of the following:

- a) One (1) Director who is the appointment from the Athlete Constituent;
- b) One (1) Director who is the appointment from the Coaching Constituent; and
- c) Three (3) other Directors appointed by the Board at large.

The Nominating Committee as composed shall meet when required and shall provide nominations to the Board to fill the two (2) member at large Director positions available on the Board which are provided for in Section 3.01, Subclause I.

Section 8 - Audit Committee

- 8.01 The Audit Committee shall be constituted by the Board of Directors and shall be composed of three (3) members of the Board who shall meet at such times as is required.

- 8.02 Such committee shall be responsible for the financial affairs of the Society and shall form the formal link between the Board of Directors and the hired auditors of the Society.

Section 9 - Execution of Instruments

9.01 Signing Authority

Any and all documents, deeds, transfers, assignments, contracts, obligations, certificates and other instruments may be executed on behalf of the Society by the Chairperson of the Society or his designate and one (1) or more other Directors. In addition, the Board may, from time to time, designate by resolution the manner in which and the persons by whom any particular instrument or class of instruments may or shall be executed and all instruments so executed shall be binding upon the Society without further authorization or formality.

9.02 Seal

The Secretary shall have charge of the seal of the Society. The Board may, from time to time, designate by resolution the persons by whom any particular instrument or class of instruments may or shall be executed under seal, however a document executed on behalf of the Society by a Director or the Secretary or an agent of the Society is not invalid only because the Society's seal is not affixed to the document.

9.03 Cheques, Drafts and Notes

All cheques, drafts or orders for the payment of money and all notes, acceptances and bills of exchange shall be signed in such manner and by such Directors of the Society or other persons or any combination of the foregoing as the Board may, from time to time, designate by resolution.

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Section 10 - Amendment of By-Laws

10.01 By-Laws Committee

A By-Laws Committee shall be appointed from time to time by the Board of Directors which committee shall review the By-Laws of the Society on a ongoing basis, receive input from the members and the community at large and shall make such recommendations to the Board of Directors for amendment of the By-Laws at each Annual General Meeting.

10.02 Special Resolution to Amend By-Law

On a written requisition of seventy-five (75%) percent of the voting members of the Society, the Chairperson shall call a Special General Meeting for the purposes of entertaining a motion to effect an amendment in the By-Laws of the Society. On such written requisition, the Chairperson shall call such Special General Meeting within thirty (30) days from the date of such special requisition.

10.03 Amendment of By-Laws

Any amendment of the By-Law of the Society shall be required to be passed as a Special Resolution by a seventy-five (75%) percent majority of members entitled at such General Meeting or such Annual General Meeting.

Section 11 - Records, Fiscal Year, Annual Report

11.01 Books and Records

The Board shall see that all necessary books and records of the Society required by the By-Laws of the Society or by any applicable statute or law are regularly and properly kept and shall, at all reasonable times during regular business hours, be open to inspection by the Active Members.

11.02 Fiscal Year

Subject to the Act, the fiscal year of the Society shall terminate on the 30th day of June in each year.

11.03 Annual Report

The Society shall prepare and, within One Hundred and Twenty (120) Days after the end of each fiscal year, submit to the Membership an annual report, which shall include the audited financial statements and any other statements and reports that the Board may require.

Section 12 - Membership Meeting

12.01 Annual Meeting

The Society shall hold an annual meeting within One Hundred and Twenty (120) Days following the end of each fiscal year of the Society. Notice of the Annual Meeting shall be by letter to the last known address of each Active Member, posted in the mail ten (10) days prior to the Annual Meeting. At the Annual Meeting, the Active Members shall confirm the action of the Board of Directors over the past year and confirm the appointment of the next ensuing Board of Directors.

12.02 Special Meetings of the Society

Special Meetings of the Society may be held at such times and at such places as the Directors may, from time to time, determine. A Special Meeting of the Society shall be called by the Society upon receipt of a petition, signed by one-third (1/3) of the Active Members of the Society, setting forth the reasons for calling such meeting or by the request of a Special Meeting by two (2) Directors as set out in Section 3.08. Notice of the Special Meeting shall be by letter to the last known address of each Active Member, posted in the mail ten (10) days prior to the meeting and specifying a date for such meeting to be no later than thirty (30) days from the date of receipt of the petition or the date of the Directors' requisition.

12.03 Quorum

The majority of Active Members in attendance at the meeting shall constitute a quorum at that meeting.

12.04 Voting

Each Active Member shall have the right to vote at any meeting of the Society. All votes must be made in person and not by proxy or otherwise. All questions shall be decided by a majority vote of those present.

Section 13 - Borrowing Powers

13.01 Powers of Society

For the purpose of carrying out its objects, the Society may borrow or raise or secure the payment of money in such manner as it thinks fit.

Section 14 - Audit

14.01 Audited Annually

The books, accounts and records of the Society shall be audited at least once each year by a duly qualified accountant appointed for that purpose at the Annual Meeting. A complete and proper statement of the standing of the accounts for the previous year shall be submitted by such auditor at the Annual Meeting of the Society. After submission by the auditor of the accounts at the Annual General Meeting, the auditor for the succeeding year shall be selected and the remuneration for such auditor shall be set.

Section 15 - Rules and Regulations

15.01 Rules and Regulations

The Board of Directors may prescribe such rules and regulations not inconsistent with these By-Laws relating to the management, operation and use of the facilities of the Society and of the National Multi-Sport Development Centre - Calgary, as they deem expedient provided that such rules and regulations shall have force and effect only until the next Annual Meeting of the members of the Society when they shall be confirmed and failing such confirmation at such Annual Meeting of the members shall and at that time cease to have any force and effect.

Section 16 - Conflict of Interest Rules

16.01 Conflict of Interest Rules

A Director or Officer who is directly or indirectly interested in a proposed contract or transaction with the Society must:

- a) Disclose fully and promptly the nature and extent of the interest to each director and officer.
- b) Absent herself or himself from all deliberations regarding said contract or transaction.
- c) Not vote or otherwise attempt to influence the decision making process regarding said contract or transaction.

Section 17 - Equity and Ethics in Sport

17.01 Equity in Sport

The Society shall conduct its activities with a responsibility for significantly advancing the concept of sport for all, that being access and equitable treatment for all segments of the Canadian population recognizing an equity between male and female participants in sport and the Society.

17.02 Ethics

The Society shall adopt a Code of Ethics for the Society and it shall be a requirement that all the members of the Society shall adhere to such Code of Ethics.
